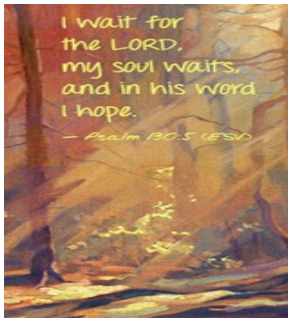

What Happens if a Host is Dropped?**Question:**

What Happens if Someone Drops a Consecrated Host?

Answer:

Despite our best efforts, and this is as true in our liturgical celebrations as in all of life, accidents happen. Occasionally at Mass, a host may be dropped or some of the Precious Blood could even be spilled from the chalice, despite the best efforts of the priests, deacons, and extraordinary ministers of holy Communion assisting at the liturgy.

So, when a host is dropped or the Precious Blood is spilled, we can take guidance from the U.S. Bishops' statement *Norms for the Distribution for Holy Communion Under Both Kinds*:

All ministers of Holy Communion should show the greatest reverence for the Most Holy Eucharist by their demeanor, their attire, and the manner in which they handle the consecrated bread or wine. Should there be any mishap — as when, for example, the consecrated wine is spilled from the chalice — then the affected "area . . . should be washed with water, and this water should be then poured into the sacrarium."

According to no. 280 of the *General Instruction of the Roman Missal*, the general rule is that a dropped host is picked up by the minister distributing Communion and reverently consumed. The minister should be careful to make sure that no other particles from the host remain on the ground. As we see in the instruction from the bishops, the Precious Blood would be absorbed (customarily with a purificator) and the area attentively and reverently washed with water which would then be disposed of properly.

¿Qué Sucede si se Descarta el Host?**Pregunta:**

¿Qué pasa si alguien deja caer una hostia consagrada?

Respuesta:

A pesar de nuestros mejores esfuerzos, y esto es cierto en nuestras celebraciones litúrgicas como toda la vida, los accidentes ocurren. Ocasionalmente en la misa, un anfitrión puede ser caído o parte de la Sangre Preciosa podría incluso ser derramada del cáliz, a pesar de los mejores esfuerzos del sacerdote, diáconos, y los ministros extraordinarios de la santa comunión que asisten a la liturgia. Por lo tanto, cuando se deja caer un anfitrión o se derrama la Sangre Preciosa, podemos tomar la guía de los *EE.UU. Normas de los obispos para la distribución de la Santa Comunión bajo ambos tipos*:

Todos los ministros de Santa Comunión deben mostrar la mayor reverencia por la Santísima Eucaristía por su comportamiento, su atuendo y la forma en que manejan el pan o el vino consagrados. En caso de que haya algún percance - así, por ejemplo, el vino consagrado se derrama del cáliz - entonces la "zona afectada" debe ser lavada con agua, y esta agua debe ser vertida en el sacrarium.

Según el número 280 de la Instrucción General del Misal Romano, la regla general es que un anfitrión caído es recogido por el ministro que distribuye la Comunión y se consume reverentemente. El ministro debe tener cuidado de asegurarse de que no queden otras partículas en el huésped en el suelo. Como vemos en la instrucción de los obispos, la Sangre Preciosa sería absorbida (habitualmente con un purificador) y el área lavada atenta y reverentemente con agua que luego sería eliminada adecuadamente.
