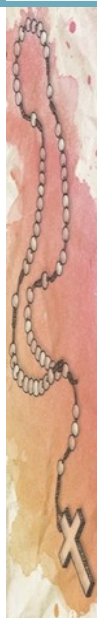

Church Teaching About Suicide

(An emotionally difficult subject on so many levels – and so important)

Question:

What does the Church say about suicide?

Answer:

Unfortunately, despite the Church's clear teachings in resources like the *Catechism of the Catholic Church* and the *United States Catholic Catechism for Adults*, there are still many people who are confused about what the Church teaches regarding the tragic reality of suicide.

While we hold that all life is sacred, we are also all-too aware that psychological, emotional and even physical illness — as well as extreme anxiety, fear, and abuse — can lead individuals to take their own lives. Speaking to this, the *United States Catholic Catechism for Adults* reflects, "Although suicide is always objectively sinful, one should not despair of the eternal salvation of persons who have taken their own lives. By ways known to him alone, God can provide the opportunity for salutary repentance. The Church prays for persons who have taken their own lives" (pg. 294). The text also states the reality of illness or other extreme influences can "diminish the responsibility of one committing suicide" (pg. 293).

Parishes and grief support groups should show special care and concern for those families that have lost a loved one to suicide. And, communities should always try to be mindful of those who might be at risk of suicide or self-harm.

If someone is contemplating suicide, please know that help is available, including the National Suicide Prevention Lifeline (1-800-273-8255).

Enseñanza de la Iglesia sobre el Suicidio

(Un tema emocionalmente difícil en muchos niveles, y tan importante)

Pregunta:

¿Qué dice la Iglesia sobre el suicidio?

Respuesta:

Desafortunadamente, a pesar de las claras enseñanzas de la Iglesia en recursos como el Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica y el Catecismo Católico de los Estados Unidos para Adultos, todavía hay muchas personas que están confundidas acerca de lo que la Iglesia enseña con respecto a la trágica realidad del suicidio.

Si bien sostenemos que toda la vida es sagrada, también somos muy conscientes de que las enfermedades psicológicas, emocionales e incluso físicas, así como la ansiedad extrema, el miedo y el abuso, pueden llevar a las personas a quitarse la vida. Hablando a esto, el Catecismo Católico de los Estados Unidos para Adultos refleja: "Aunque el suicidio es siempre objetivamente pecaminoso, uno no debe desesperarse de la salvación eterna de las personas que se han quitado la vida. Por medio de maneras conocidas por él solo, Dios puede proporcionar la oportunidad para el arrepentimiento saludable. La Iglesia ora por las personas que se han quitado la vida" (pág. 294). El texto también establece que la realidad de la enfermedad u otras influencias extremas pueden "disminuir la responsabilidad de quien se suicida" (pág. 293).

Las parroquias y los grupos de apoyo de duelo deben mostrar especial cuidado y preocupación por aquellas familias que han perdido a un ser querido por suicidio. Y, las comunidades siempre deben tratar de ser conscientes de aquellos que podrían estar en riesgo de suicidio o autolesión.
