### ASH WEDNESDAY

**Question:** Is Ash Wednesday a Catholic Holy Day of Obligation?

**Answer:** Ash Wednesday is *not* a Holy Day of Obligation for Roman Catholics, yet receiving ashes is a universal practice among Christians to begin their Lenten journeys.

**Question:** Do I need to be Catholic to receive ashes

**Answer:** You do not need to be Catholic to receive ashes on Ash Wednesday. Several other traditions within Christianity also share this act of repentance.

**Question:** Why is Ash Wednesday important?

**Answer:** As the first day of Lent, Ash Wednesday awakens us to Jesus' entry into the desert preceding his death. Before Easter, however, we must prepare our hearts for his Resurrection. We begin our season of preparing our hearts for Easter by recognizing our brokenness and need for conversion, a turning of our hearts to God.

**Question:** Where do the ashes go?

**Answer:** It is typical to receive ashes on your forehead in the Sign of the Cross. Similar to taking communion at Mass, you usually process toward the altar to get ashes. The priest will make the Sign of the Cross and say one of two things:

- “Remember that you are dust, and unto dust you shall return.”
- “Repent, and believe in the Gospel.”

**Question:** What do the ashes symbolize?

**Answer:** The ashes symbolize our mortality. They are a physical reminder that our bodies will decay, but our souls will live on in eternal life.

Fr. Antony Kadavil further reflects on the symbol of the cross of ashes on our foreheads:

“The cross of ashes means that we are making a commitment – that we are undertaking Lent as a season of prayer and penitence, of dying to ourselves. It also describes our human condition: it says that we are broken and need repair; that we are sinners and need redemption. Most importantly, it tells us that, as followers of Jesus Christ, we are to carry our crosses.”

### MIÉRCOLES DE CENIZA

**Pregunta:** ¿Es el Miércoles de Ceniza un Día Santo católico de obligación?

**Respuesta:** El Miércoles de Ceniza no es un Día Santo de Obligación para los Católicos Romanos, sin embargo, recibir cenizas es una práctica universal entre los cristianos para comenzar sus viajes de Cuaresma.

**Pregunta:** ¿Necesito ser católico para recibir cenizas?

**Respuesta:** No necesitas ser católico para recibir cenizas el Miércoles de Ceniza. Varias otras tradiciones dentro del cristianismo también comparten este acto de arrepentimiento.

**Pregunta:** ¿Por qué es importante el Miércoles de Ceniza?

**Respuesta:** Como el primer día de Cuaresma, el Miércoles de Ceniza nos despierta a la entrada de Jesús en el desierto antes de su muerte. Antes de la Pascua, sin embargo, debemos preparar nuestros corazones para su Resurrección. Comenzamos nuestra temporada de preparación de nuestros corazones para la Pascua reconociendo nuestro quebrantamiento y necesidad de conversión, una vuelta de nuestros corazones a Dios.

**Pregunta:** ¿A dónde van las cenizas?

**Respuesta:** Es típico recibir cenizas en la frente en la Señal de la Cruz. Similar a tomar la comunión en la misa, por lo general se procesa hacia el altar para obtener cenizas. El sacerdote hará la Señal de la Cruz y dirá una de dos cosas:

- "Recordad que sois polvo, y para el polvo lo haréis volver".
- "Arrepentíos y creed en el Evangelio".

**Pregunta:** ¿Qué simbolizan las cenizas?

**Respuesta:** Las cenizas simbolizan nuestra mortalidad. Son un recordatorio físico de que nuestros cuerpos se descompondrán, pero nuestras almas vivirán en la vida eterna. El P. Antony Kadavil reflexiona además sobre el símbolo de la cruz de las cenizas en nuestras frentes:

"La cruz de cenizas significa que estamos haciendo un compromiso, que estamos emprendiendo la Cuaresma como un tiempo de oración y penitencia, de morir a nosotros mismos. También describe nuestra condición humana: dice que estamos rotos y necesitamos reparación; que somos pecadores y necesitamos redención. Lo más importante es que nos dice que, como seguidores de Jesucristo, debemos llevar nuestras cruces".

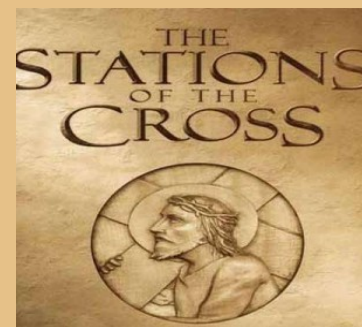

### FAST & ABSTINENCE

Ash Wednesday, Good Friday & all Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of fasting & abstinence for Catholics. For members of the Latin Catholic Church, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 -59.

#### Fasting requires:

1 full meal & 2 small meals that together do not equal a full meal. Abstinence from meat is binding for those age 14 onwards.

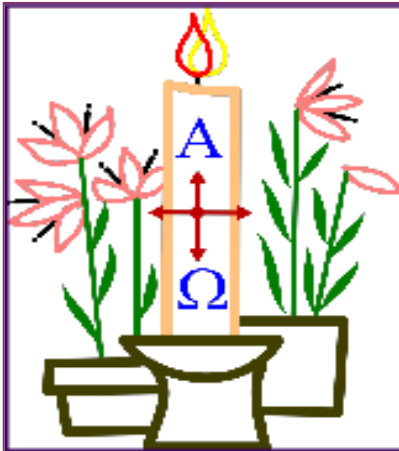
